To Edwin J. Gerry, Constable of
the Town of Sudbury in said County Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
you are hereby required to notify and warn the
inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified as
the Constitution requires to vote in town af-
fairs to assemble at the Town Hall in said Town
on Monday the Fifth day of September next at
two of the Clock in the afternoon, then and
there to act on the following Subject, Viz.

- Art 1 To Choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting.
- Art 2 To see if the Town will choose a committee to let out
the raising of the Carrieway on the road leading
from Sudbury Centre to Wayland as ordered by
the County Commissioners on petition of Webster,
Moore and others, to do or act in reference to said
subject as the Town shall think proper.
- Art 3 To see if the Town will grant leave to Levi Dow
to erect a fence around a lot in the new Burial
Ground, to do or act &c.
- Art 4 To see if the Town will take any measures to remove
the wall in front of the new Burial Ground, so
that the same may conform to the Limits of the
Highway as created by the County Commissioners on
petition of Cyrus Hunt & others, to do or act &c.
- Art 5 To hear and act on reports.
