Art. 9 To see if the town will give their Overseers of the Poor any instructions in reference to Georganna Haynes to do or act to

Art. 10 To see if the town will accept of a road laid out by the County Commissioners and pay for the same, also to see if the town will accept of another piece of road laid out by the selectmen of Sudbury and pay the same

Art. 11 to hear and act on reports

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up ^{an} attested printed copy of the same at the town house, at each of the public meeting houses in said town and at the counting room of Amory Maynard at Assabet, two sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not, and make due return of this warrant, with your doings thereon to the town clerk at or before the time of meeting aforesaid.
