Art 3^d Voted to grant the sum of twelve hundred and fifty dollars. for the repairs on Highways. Town ways & Bridges. the ensuing year. to be distributed in the same manner as last year - that 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ cents per hour be the price paid by the surveyors for Labor - that one sixth part of the above grant be reserved for the winter to be expended in breaking out roads, and if the same be not so expended. that it shall be worked out by the surveyors before the first of May following.

Voted also. that the Assessors be instructed to make any alterations in the limits of the several Highway wards, which they shall judge to be for the interest of the town
