

Mo. April 1860

At a legal Town Meeting holden at the Town Hall in the town of Shelbury on Monday the second day of April A.D. 1860. the Articles in the preceding Warrants were taken up and acted upon as follows viz:

- Art 1st Chose Nelson Fairbank. Moderator
- Art 2^d Chose Lemuel P. Brown. Lewis C. Puffer and Elisha Moore L. Field Drivers in place of Edwin A. Gerry. John Hawyer & Elisha Moore, Chosen at March Meeting
Chose Nelson Fairbank. Andrew Knist. Webster Marie Joseph D. Cutter, Spencer W. Brown. Highway Surveyors. in place of Thomas E. Bent. John W. Haynes. Uriah Moore, Isaac Clark and Meloniram J. Bacon chosen at March Meeting.
Voted that the appointment of Pound Keeper. Surveyors of Wood and Lumber and Sealers of weights and measures. be left to the Selectmen.
- Art 3^d Voted To Pass over this Article
- Art 4 Voted To appropriate the sum of thirty dollars for ringing the bell in the Centre of the town provided it be rung by the same person as last year. - that the bell be rung at 12 o'clock M. and 9 o'clock P.M.
- Art 5 Voted to pass over this Article
- Art 6 Voted to pass over this Article.
- Art 7 Voted to instruct the Select men to paint or caused to be painted the fences around the Wadsworth Monument
