Art 10

Voted, that the money received by the town as tax upon dogs, for the year 1859, be appropriated for the benefit of the industrious poor in town, under the direction of the Selectmen

Art 11

The report of the School Committee was read by the Chairman, and accepted by the Town after striking out certain recommendations contained therein relating to the school house in the Centre district.

Report of the Committee on accounts read and accepted and the town voted to grant the sum of \$223.37 to pay the same

Report of the Committee chosen to let out the raising of the Causeway ^{near Wayland line}, Accepted, and said Committee was authorized to Borrow money to pay for raising said causeway if it becomes due before the grant for that purpose is collected

Report of Committee on Hears house. Accepted, and the subject of repairing or rebuilding the said Hears house was left to the Selectmen.

Report of the Selectmen on Guide boards, read and Accepted and the Selectmen were instructed to put up Guide boards at such places as they have recommended in their report.

Report of the Selectmen on the receipts and expenditures of the Town House for the year ending April, 2, 1860. Accepted.

Art 12

Voted that the Taxes for the year 1860 be made payable as follows, viz. all single Poll Taxes payable on demand all other taxes against residents of the Town, payable in three equal installments as follows, the first on the first day of September, the second, on the first day of November, the third on the first day of February, and all taxes of Non-residents payable in full at the time of the second installment.
