- Art 13 the fault or neglect of the person taking care of the house, he shall make the same good to the town without charge.
The person taking care of the house shall give bonds if required by the Selectmen
Then let out the taking care of the house to Webster Moore for the sum of forty^{eight} dollars.
- Art 12 This Article was again taken up and a verbal report made by the Overseers of the Poor concerning the condition of Georgianna Haynes an insane pauper, and the town voted to instruct said Overseers to cause said Georgianna Haynes to be placed in the Insane Hospital at Worcester.
- Art 14 Voted to instruct the Selectmen to print the receipts and Expenditures of the present year.
- Art 15 Voted to instruct the Assessors to print a list of the Polls and Estates in the Town of Sudbury the present year with the Assessments upon the same.
- Art 16 Voted to accept the following list of jurors as made out by the Selectmen viz: Thomas E. Bent, Joseph D. Cutter, Levi Dow, John H. Dakin, Nelson Fairbank, George Goodnow, Edwin A. Lacey, Aaron Mount, Andrew Mount, Nicholas B. Mount, Luther G. Mount, Josiah Haynes, Elisha W. Haynes, Thomas P. Hurlbut, Abel B. Jones, George W. Gates, James Moore, George W. Moore, George Parmenter, Oliver R. Rice, Ephraim Stone, Charles Thompson, Artemas Whitney, Moses W. Waynard, Thomas L. Dakin, John W. Rice, John Taylor.
- Art 17 Voted that the Selectmen be the committee to make the distribution of the interest arising from the "Elisha Goodnow" and other funds.
