Niel Olsson S.S. To either of the Constables of the Town
Sudbury in said County Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, qualified to vote in elections to meet at the Town Hall in said Sudbury on Monday the seventh day of May next at one of the clock in the afternoon to bring in their votes by Ballot for or against the following articles of Amendment to the Constitution of Massachusetts:

First Article of Amendment, "Any vacancy in the Senate shall be filled by election by the people of the unrepresented District upon the order of a majority of the Senators elected."

Second Article of Amendment "In case of a vacancy in the Council from a failure of Election or other Cause, the Senate and House of Representatives shall, by Concurrent vote choose some eligible person from the district wherein such vacancy occurs, to fill that office. If such vacancy shall happen when the Legislature is not in session, the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council, may fill the same by appointment of some eligible person."
