

regulations regarding the care and distribution of the same; and also make regulations regarding the distribution of the interest arising upon the Elisha Goodnow fund, for books and the care of the books furnished thereby, to do &c &c

Art 9th To see if the Town will build a new school house in the Centre District, or enlarge the old one and cause the school in said district to be divided, and grant and appropriate money to carry the same into effect to do &c.

Art 10 To see if the Town will authorize their Select men to sell their old house, or convert it into a winter house and provide a place to keep the same, to do &c.

Art 11 To see if the Town will grant a sum of money in addition to the highway grant to be expended upon the road leading to the house of Wheeler Moore.

And you are directed to serve this warrant, by posting up an attested printed copy thereof, at the Town House, at each of the public Meeting houses in said town, and at some public place in the Village of Assabet, in said Sudbury, two Sabbaths at least before the time appointed for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not, and make due return of this warrant, with your doings thereon, to ourselves, at or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
