

May 1860

At a Legal Meeting of the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in elections holden at the Town Hall in said Town on Monday the seventh day of May A.D. 1860. the following votes were given in to the Selectmen by ballot on the several Amendments to the Constitution of Massachusetts. Viz;

First Article of Amendment Yeas. twenty six. Nocs. Seven.

Second Article of Amendment Yeas. twenty four. Nocs. Nine.

And the Town Voted to dissolve this meeting

At a Legal Town Meeting holden at the Town Hall in Sudbury on Monday May 7th 1860 the Articles in the preceding Warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows. Viz;

Art 1st Chose Capt James Moore, Moderator

Art 2^d Voted that the several school Libraries be brought to the Town Hall. at the time of the annual Meeting of the Town in November next, and sold at public Auction, at 12 o'clock M.

Art 3 Voted that the money granted for the support of Schools, at the annual meeting in April last, be distributed equally among the several school districts

Art 4 Voted to Pass over this Article

Art 5 Voted to Pass over this Article

Art 6 Voted to Choose a committee of three to examine Wash Bridge. with reference to repairing or rebuilding the same, and report at some future town meeting, and chose James Moore, Webster Moore & Henry Vase for said committee

Art 7 Voted to authorize the Selectmen to borrow
