- Art. 3. To see if the Town will purchase gravel pits in the wards where they are needed.
- Art. 4. To see if the Town will give free use of the Upper Hall in the Town House for a Music School.
- Art. 5. To hear and act on any reports which may be presented.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting and attested copy thereof at the Town House, and at each of the public Meeting-Houses, and at some public place in the village of Assabet, in said town two sabbaths at least before the time appointed for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not, and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon, to ourselves, at or before the time of meeting aforesaid.
