Report of Committee appointed to examine the road
 near the house of Wheeler Moore. accepted.

Voted that the Selectmen be ordered to examine said
 road and cause the sum of twenty dollars to be ex-
 pended thereon if they think it necessary.

 ing in the above mentioned business and the Mod-
 erator decides it to be the duty of the other Selectmen
 Mr Charles Thompson to attend to it.
