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Middlesex S.S. To either of the Constables in Town
of Sudbury and County of Middlesex. Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
you are directed to notify and warn the inhabitants
of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs
to meet at the Town Hall in said Sudbury on
Monday the 14th day of January current at one
o'clock in the afternoon and there to act on
the following articles, viz:

Art 1st To Choose a Moderator to preside in said Meeting

Art 2^d To see if the Town will remonstrate against the
petition of C. P. & T. Talbot for the repeal of an act
known as an act in relation to the flowage of
the meadows on Concord and Sudbury rivers.
To do or act in reference to said petition as the
town may think proper.

Art 3^d To see if the Town will authorize the Selectmen to use
for incidental purposes the unappropriated money
now in the Treasury, to do or act &c.

Art 4th To see if the Town will purchase additional lamps
for the Town Hall, to do or act &c.

Art 5th To hear and act on all reports which may be presented.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting
up an attested printed copy thereof at each of the
public meeting houses in said town, and at some
public place in the village of Assabet in said
town, two sabbaths at least before the time for
holding said meeting.
