Town of Sudbury in said County. Greeting:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts,
you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhab-
itants of the Town of Sudbury, qualified to vote in Town
affairs, to assemble at the Town Hall, in said Town, on
Monday, the fourth day of March, next, at ten of the
clock, in the forenoon, then and there to act on
the following articles, viz:

- Art 1st To choose a Moderator to preside in said Meeting
- Art 2^d To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.
- Art 3^d To determine the manner of repairing the highways
Town ways and bridges the year ensuing, and grant
money to carry the same into effect
- Art 4th To determine the manner of warning town meetings
the year ensuing.
- Art 5 To see if the Town will authorize their Assessors to ap-
portion to the Warden of their Poor Establishment all
the road adjoining their farm to keep in repair the
ensuing year to do or act as the Town may think proper.
- Art 6 To see if the Town will instruct the Selectmen to
purchase gravel pits within the wards where they
are needed; to do or act &c
- Art 7 To see if the Town will discount a part of John W.
Haynes' tax for eighteen hundred sixty; to do or act &c
- Art 8 To see if the Town will give to the Wadsworth Rifle Guards
a part of the Armory Rent for eighteen hundred sixty
