

Art 3^d Voted to grant the same sum of money (\$1250) for the repairs of Highways, town ways & Bridges, as last year; and that the same be expended in the same manner.
Voted to instruct the Selectmen to examine all roads complained of, with reference to a special grant of money to repair said roads, and report at the annual Town Meeting in April next.

Art 4th Voted that the Town meetings for the ensuing year, be warned, by posting up attested, printed, copies of the warrants for said meetings at the Town House, at each of the public Meeting houses in said town, and at some public place in the Village of Assabel, two sabbaths at least before the time appointed for holding said meetings.

Art 5th Voted to Authorize the Assessors to apportion to the Warden of their Poor Establishment, all the road adjoining the Poor Farm to keep in repair the ensuing year.

Art 6. Voted to pass over this Article.

Art 7. Voted to instruct the Selectmen to purchase gravel pits in the several highway wards where they are needed.

Art 8. Voted to pass over this Article.

Art 9. Voted to instruct the Selectmen to remove all fences that have been set into the highways in town, by the owners thereof, unless in the judgement of said Selectmen, such alterations are of no injury to the highways or the town.

Art 10 Voted to instruct the highway surveyor in the Hill Village Ward, to remove, forthwith, the stones that were left near the house of Revland Cutter for the purpose of building a sluice.
