In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts,
you are directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants
of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in Town affairs
to meet at the Town Hall in said Town, on
Monday, the first day of April next, then and
there to act on the following Articles viz,

- Art 1 To choose a Moderator to preside at said Meeting.
- Art 2 To choose all necessary Town officers not chosen at
March meeting and fill all vacancies that may
have occurred by non-acceptance or otherwise.
- Art 3 To hear the report of the selectmen on the condition
of the several roads in Town, and pass any votes
relative thereto as the Town may judge best.
- Art 4 To accept of a list of furors presented by the Selectmen.
- Art 5 To see if the Town will pay for ringing the bell daily the present year.
- Art 6 To see if the Town will paint their Town House the present year.
- Art 7 To grant money for all necessary Town purposes ^{for} the
year ensuing, and appropriate the same.
- Art 8 To determine for what purposes, and on what conditions
the Town Hall may be used the present year, and
agree with some suitable person to take care of the same.
- Art 9 To see if the Town will paint the inside of their School
Houses the present year.
