

April 1861

At a legal Town Meeting holden at Sudbury, on Monday the first day of April A.D. 1861, the Articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows, viz:

Art 1 Chose Capt James Moore, Moderator,

Art 2 Chose Abel B. Jones Webster Moore and Joel Parmenter Fence Viewers to fill Vacancies

Chose Emery Smith, Willard Kemmeway and George Smith 2 Highway Surveyors in place of A. N. Bowker, John B. Goodnow, and Andrew Hunt, chosen at March Meeting.

Chose James Moore a Surveyor of lumber in place of Ephraim Moore deceased.

Voted that the selectmen appoint Field Drivers to fill vacancies if necessary.

Art 3 Voted to accept the report of the selectmen relating to roads and grant the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to be expended on the North road, and one hundred and fifty dollars to be divided between those roads where it may be the most needed.

Then chose Abel B. Jones a committee to superintend the laying out of said grant on the north road, and Webster Moore to superintend the laying out of the remainder of the said grant. And the committee are instructed to let out the carting of the gravel by the load and attend personally to the grading and levelling of the same.

Art 4 Voted to accept the following list of jurors as offered by the selectmen, Viz: Joseph D. Cutter, John C. Dakin, Nelson Fairbank, George Goodnow, Edwin A. Gery, Andrew Hunt, Nicholas B. Hunt, Josiah Haynes, Elisha W. Haynes, Thomas P. Kurlbut, Abel B. Jones, Isaac M. Jones, James Moore, George W. Moore, George Parmenter
