Act 8 Voted that the Town Hall be used for the same purposes and on the same conditions as last year.

Voted to let out the taking care of the Town house to the lowest bidder, the person taking care of the same to open, warm, light, sweep, and wash the Hall when necessary, be present at all times when the house is open.
