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- Art 12 Then the Town chose the said John Goodnow 2^d Collector of Taxes for the ensuing year by Ballot
- Art 13 Voted to instruct the select men to borrow money to pay accounts allowed by the auditors, if necessary
- Art 14 Voted to instruct the select men to print the receipts and expenditures of the town the present year.
- Art 15 Voted to instruct the Assessors to print the valuation and taxes of the town the present year, afterwards reconsidered the above vote
- Art 16 Voted to accept the report of the School Committee and ordered said committee to cause a sufficient number of copies of said report to be printed for general distribution in the town
- Art 17 Voted not to purchase a safe for the use of the Treasurer.
- Art 18 Voted to allow the Wadsworth Rifle Guards twenty dollars, out of the money received from the State for Armory Rent.
- Art 19 Voted that the select men be a committee to make the distribution of the interest arising from the "Elisha Goodnow" and all other funds.
- Art 20 Voted to pass over this Article.

Then Voted to dissolve the meeting
