At a Legal Town meeting holden at Sudbury
on Monday the 29th day of April A.D. 1861. the articles
in the preceding warrants were taken up and
acted upon as follows, viz:

Art. 1st Chose Capt James Moore, Moderator.

Art 2 Voted to instruct the Assessors to print the
valuation and assessment of taxes the present
year.

Art 3rd The Town voted to furnish a new uniform for
the members of the "Wadsworth Rifle Guards"
Company B. 2^d Battalion of Rifles. M. V. M. forth-
with, also to furnish each member of said
Company with a revolver, in case said com-
pany is called into the service of the Country,
the revolvers to be returned to the Selectmen
of the Town, when the holders of them shall return
home and be discharged from the service, also
the uniforms to be returned to the Town if the
members of the Company are not held in service
