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not belonging in town be furnished with the same if they are not otherwise provided for.

Then chose Capt. Abel B. Jones, Capt. James Moore and Capt. Hopestill Brown, a committee to carry into effect the above vote.

Voted to give the use of the Hall to the company for the purpose of drilling & also to give the use of the same to the ladies who propose to assist in making up the uniforms.

Voted to instruct the Selectmen to borrow the sum of six hundred dollars to pay for the uniforms of the company, and such other sums of money as ^{may} be necessary to carry into effect any and all other votes passed under this article.

Voted to grant the sum of one thousand dollars for the purposes named in this article, and that the said amount be assessed upon the inhabitants of the town the present year.

Then Voted to dissolve this meeting
