Art 2^d Voted to pay all members of the "Wadsworth Rifle
Guards" who went to Fort Independence on the 29th
day of June 1861, for drilling at the rate of fifty
cents for each half day's time spent previous to
the ^{passage of the} act of the Mass. Legislature prohibiting the
same

Voted to allow all members referred to in the above
vote to keep the Uniforms presented to them by the
town if they wish so to do, and that the other uni-
forms be collected by the Military Committee, and
deposited in the town house, to be disposed of as
the town may think best

Art 3^d Voted that the selectmen be instructed ^{to} provide
for the families of the Volunteers who have en-
listed into the service of the United States, as
they think necessary, agreeable to an act passed
by the Mass. Legislature on the twenty third
day of May 1861

Art 4 Voted to authorize the Selectmen to use any
unappropriated money now in the Treasury
to pay town expenses for the present year.

Then Voted to dissolve this Meeting
