the Depot at Assabet Village in said town
two Sabbaths before the time of holding said meet-
ing, as therein directed.

At a Legal Town Meeting holden at Sudbury
on Monday the nineteenth day of August, A.D. 1861.
the Articles in the preceding warrant were
taken up and acted upon as follows, viz

Art 1 Chose Capt James Moore, Moderator.

Art 2 The Committee of thirteen, chosen at a legal
town meeting holden April 29th 1861, for the
purpose of fitting out the Military Company,
Reported that the whole amount of money expend-
ed by them for all purposes connected with the
military company is nine hundred, eighty seven
dollars, seventeen cents (\$987.17), and said
report was accepted by the town.

Voted that the above committee be instructed
to dispose of the remainder of the cloth which
was purchased for Uniforms, and not used,
and that the proceeds be paid into the
Treasury of the town.

Voted to instruct said Committee not to purchase
revolvers for the soldiers, as had been heretofore proposed.
