- Art 2^d To see if the Town will lay a part of the wall around the new Burying Ground, to do or act as the Town may think best.
- Art 3 To see if the Town will put some gravel in front of the Town House and make it more convenient for carriages to pass to or from the same, to do or act as the Town may judge best.
- Art 4. To hear and act on all reports and pass any votes relative thereto that the Town may think best.
- Art 5 To see if the Town will pay a Bounty of ten dollars to all Soldier's that have enlisted into the service of the United States, who have not already been paid that sum, to do or act as the Town may think best.
- Art 6 To see if the Town will make any addition to the buildings on the Poor Farm to do or act as the Town may think best.

And you are directed to serve this warrant, by posting an attested Copy thereof, at the Town House, and at each of the public Meeting Houses in said Town and at some public place in the village of Assabet in said Town, two sabbaths at least before the time appointed for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon, to ourselves at or before the time of meeting aforesaid.
