To Samuel A Jones as Constable of the
Town of Sudbury in said County. Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
you are required to notify and warn the inhabitants
of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in Elec-
tions, to meet at the Town Hall in said Sud-
bury, on Tuesday the fifth day of November,
next, it being the next Tuesday after the first
Monday of said month, at eleven of the clock, in
the forenoon, to bring in their votes to the Selectmen
for a Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary,
Treasurer and Receiver General, Auditor of
Accounts, and Attorney General for this Com-
monwealth, a Councillor for District No. Six, and
a Senator for District No. three, all on one
Ballot.

Also, to give in their votes for a Register
of Deeds, Clerk of Courts, Treasurer and Com-
missioner, for Middlesex County, and a Rep-
resentative in the next General Court of this Com-
monwealth for District No. Sixteen, upon a
separate Ballot, all the foregoing ballots to
be deposited at one checking. Polls to be open
at twelve o'clock M. and may be closed at 2
o'clock P. M.

And you are also required to notify and warn
the inhabitants of said town of Sudbury qualified
to vote in town affairs, to assemble at the Town
Hall in said town, on Tuesday, the fifth day
of November next, at 1 o'clock in the afternoon,
to act on the following articles, Viz.

Art 1 To Choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting
