Art 2 Voted to instruct the Select men to build a suitable wall around the new Town Burying Ground wherever it is needed, and required by law also to construct a gate way between said new Burying Ground and the Union Burying Ground, (so called), provided the Select men and the proprietors of said Union Burying Ground can agree in regard to the matter.

Art 4 Report of Committee on painting Town House read & Accepted

Verbal report by Overseers of Poor relative to condition of Charles W. Wiley an insane pauper at the State Lunatic Hospital, and the whole subject was referred back to the Overseers

Art 5 Voted to pay a bounty of ten dollars to each person belonging in Town who has enlisted into the service of the United States, provided such persons have received no bounty from any other source

Art 6 Passed Over

Then Voted to dissolve this meeting
