At a legal Town Meeting holden at Sudbury on Monday the 20th day of January A.D. 1862 the Articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted on as follows, Viz:

Art 2^d. Voted to choose two Agents to remonstrate against the petition of Messrs C.P. & T. Talbot, referred to in this Article, and to take such action relative to said subject, in behalf of the Town, as the said Agents shall judge best.

Then chose Messrs Elisha W. Haynes and George W. Moore, for said Agents

Voted to pay said Agents a reasonable compensation

Art 3 No Action taken on this Article

Art 4 Voted to Pass over this Article

Then voted to dissolve this Meeting
