To Samuel A Jones, a Constable of the
Town of Sudbury in said County. Greeting:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
you are hereby required to notify and warn the
inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury Qualified to
vote in Town affairs to meet at the Town Hall
in said Sudbury on Monday the third day of March
next at ten o'clock in the forenoon then and there
to act on the following articles, viz:

- Art 1 To Choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting
- Art 2 To Choose all necessary Town officers for the
year ensuing.
- Art 3 To see if the Town will take any measures to
straighten the dividing line between the towns
of Sudbury and Wayland, to do or act in refer-
ence to said line as the town shall judge best.
- Art 4 To determine the manner of repairing highways
Town ways & bridges the year ensuing and grant
money to carry the same into effect, to do or act
on said subject as the town may think best.
- Art 5 To determine the manner of warning town
meetings the year ensuing
- Art 6 To see if the Town will authorize their Assessors
to apportion to the Warden of the Poor Farm,
all the road adjoining their farm to keep
in repair the ensuing year to do or act as
the Town may think best
- Art 7 To see if the Town will purchase gravel
in the Highway wards where it may be
necessary to do or act as the town may
think best.
