- Art 13 To see if the town will instruct the selectmen to borrow money to pay bills that may be brought against the Town, if it should be necessary
- Art 14 To see if the town will instruct the selectmen to print the receipts and expenditures the present year
- Art 15 To see if the Town will instruct the Assessors to print the Valuation of Real and Personal Estates and the assessment of Taxes thereon the year ensuing.
- Art 16 To see if the Town will authorize some person or persons to sell lots in the new Burying Ground, to do or act on said subject as the town may think proper
- Art 17 To see if the Town will choose a committee or committees to make the distribution of the interest arising upon the Elesha Goodnow and other funds
- Art 18 To hear and act on Reports, and pass any votes relative to the same that the town may think best
- Art 19 To see if the Town will make the highway tax of nonresidents a money Tax. to do or act as the town may judge best

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the Town House at each of the public Meeting houses, and at some public place in the Village of Assabet in said town, two sabbaths at least before the time of holding said meeting.

Whereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk at the time and place of meeting as aforesaid.
