At a legal Town Meeting holden at Sndbury
on Monday the seventh day of April A.D. 1862
the Articles in the preceding Warrant were

Art 1 Chose James Moore Moderator.

Art 2 Messrs Ephraim Stone, John B Goodnow and
George W. Moore, chosen Assessors at March
Meeting, declined serving, and the town
voted not to choose Assessors for the present
year, and the selectmen were instructed
to fill any and all other vacancies by
appointment

Art 3 Voted to grant money for the following purposes.
For support of Schools, the sum of 1300.00
" Fuel for Schools " " 150.00
" Support of Poor " " 727.71
To make up deficiency of Incidentals of last year 415.88
Amount Carried forward \$2593.59
