At a legal Town Meeting holden at Snelburg on Monday the 5th day of May A.D. 1862 the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows viz.

- Art 1st Chose Dea. Thomas P. Hurlbut, Moderator
- Art 2^d Voted to choose, by ballot, a committee of six persons, to be chosen, one from each school district, and to be called a building Committee. Then chose the following persons for the above committee, viz. Jonas S. Hunt for the Centre District. Samuel Puffer, for the S.E. District. John B.
