To Samuel A Jones, a constable of the Town of Sudbury in said County Meeting;

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Sudbury on Monday, the fifth day of May next at 1 o'clock in the afternoon, then and there to act on the following articles, viz:

- Art 1st To choose a Moderator to preside in said Meeting
- Art 2^d To take measures for erecting a suitable Building for the use of the Library in accordance with the will of the late John Goodnow, of Boston, and to take any other action on the subject of said Library, which the Town may think best.
- Art 3^d To see if the Town will rescind any vote or votes passed at the Town Meeting on Monday, April 7th, 1862, relative to the bequests of the late John Goodnow of Boston.
- Art 4th To see if the Town will purchase stone to cover the Bridge near the house of Thomas Patrick and William Lyon, to do or act as the Town may think best.
- Art 5th To hear and act on reports

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting an attested copy thereof at the Town House at each of the public Meeting houses and at some public place in the Village of Assabet in said Town two Sabbaths at least before the time appointed for holding said Meeting.
