Art 2^d Voted to instruct the Selectmen to pay to the sister of John P. Hudson, the amount of one dollar per week, from the date of said Hudson's enlistment into the service of the United States.

Art 3^d The "Library Building Committee" made a verbal report to the Town, accompanied by a plan of the proposed library building, and the Town voted to accept said Report. The Town also voted that said committee be instructed to put up a building, according to the plan reported, within one year, and that the whole cost of said building, including the cellar & underpinning, preparation of the spot, fencing, grading, and pay of the committee, shall not exceed the sum of twenty five hundred dollars, bequeathed to the Town by the late John Goodnow of Boston and whatever sum in addition, that may have been or may be subscribed by individuals for said purpose;

Voted also, that the committee shall receive pay, for all their services
