In the name of the Commonwealth of Mass.
achusetts you are directed to notify the
inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qual-
ified to vote in town affairs, to meet at
the Town Hall in said Sudbury on Tuesday
the 19th instant at four o'clock in the after-
noon to act on the following articles, Viz:

Art 1st To Choose a Moderator to preside in said
Meeting

Art 2^d To see if the town will pay a bounty to those
persons who may enlist as volunteers into
the service of the United States for the term
of nine months, agreeable to an order from
the Secretary of War of the fourth instant,
to do or act in any way on the subject of
said bounty and volunteers as the town
may think best and also borrow money
to carry the same into effect

Art 3^d To see if the town will furnish aid to the
family of any person or persons who may
be drafted into the service of the United
States from said town for the term
of nine months, to do or act on said sub-
ject as the town may judge best.

And you are directed to serve this ^{warrant} by giving
each legal voter at least twenty four hours
notice of the time and place of the afore-
said meeting.
