Then the Town voted to adjourn this meeting to Thursday, Augt. 28th at 5 o'clock P.M.

Thursday August 28th 1862.

The Meeting assembled according to adjournment and took up the 2^d Article of the Warrant.

Art 2 Voted to instruct the Selectmen to use all their influence to encourage voluntary enlistments of persons into the United States' service for nine months.

Voted also to extend the time of paying one hundred dollars bounty to persons who voluntarily enlist for the nine months service, from the first of September, until the quota of the town is filled or a draft ordered.

Art 3 Voted to pass over this Article.

Then voted, to dissolve this meeting
