At a Legal town meeting holden at Suddbury on Tuesday the 19th day of August A.D. 1862, the Articles in the preceding warrent were taken up and acted upon as follows viz:

Art 1 Chose Capt James Moore Moderator,

Art 2 Voted to pay the sum of one hundred dollars to each person who voluntarily enlists into the service of the United States for the term of nine months, - on or before the first day of September next, to a number not exceeding the quota of this town; the preceding vote passed by 109 votes in the affirmative to 12 in the negative, and Mr Oliver W Hayes a legal voter of the town of Suddbury entered his protest against said vote and requested the same to be recorded
