in the afternoon to act on the following articles, viz:

- Article 1st - To Choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting
- Art. 2^d - To see if the town will give the Selectmen any instructions in reference to a lot of ground in the new Cemetery for the erection of a Tomb by the executors of the will of the late John Goodnow, of Boston: to do or act on said subject as the town shall think best;
- Art. 3^d - To see if the town will take any part of the fund left by the late John Goodnow, of Boston, for a Library, to pay the bounty to the soldiers voted by the town, the town paying the interest on the sum taken. Also, to see if the town will give the Selectmen any instructions in reference to investing any part of said fund: to do or act in any way on the foregoing articles as the town may judge best;
- Art. 4th - To see if the town will choose a committee to purchase Books for a Library, with any part of the fund left for that purpose by the late John Goodnow, of Boston, or use only the the interest as it may arise from said fund to do or act in any way in reference to said Library as the town may judge best
- Art. 5th - To see if the town will take any measures to have a history of the town written; to do or act in any way on said subject as the town may think best;
- Art. 6th - To hear and act on reports;
