Art 2^d Voted, that the Selectmen in Company with Capt Abel B. Jones, be instructed to ascertain what can be done, with reference to sending men to file up the town's quotas and that they be authorized to make such bargain or arrangement as shall seem to them proper and for the interest of the town
 Voted, also, to authorize the Selectmen to borrow money, if necessary to carry into effect any arrangement that may be made.

Art 3 Voted that the committee chosen to purchase books for the Goodnow Library, be authorized to use such sum of money as they shall think proper, (not exceeding two thousand dollars,) in addition to the amount already voted, for said purpose.

Art 4th Voted that the committee chosen to purchase books be instructed to draft such rules and regulations for the management of the Goodnow Library as they think proper, and report the same to the town for acceptance at the next town meeting

Voted also to instruct the same committee to purchase such furniture as may be necessary for the Library Building, and pay for the same out of the amount voted for the purchase of Books

Voted, also to authorize the same committee to appoint a Librarian if necessary, to serve until the annual Town meeting in March next

Art 5th Voted to authorize the above committee to prepare the books which they purchase, for circulation, and prepare a catalogue of the same.
