At a Legal Town Meeting holden at
Sudbury on Wednesday Dec. 17. A.D. 1862.
the articles in the preceding warrant
were taken up and acted upon as
follows, viz:

Art 1st Chose Capt James Moore, Moderator

Art 2^d The Committee chosen at the last Town
Meeting, to see what could be done with
reference to raising men for the Military
Service of the United States, made a verbal
report, to the effect that a sufficient num-
ber of men could be procured for three
years service to fill up the towns quota
by paying for the same, the sum of one
hundred and forty dollars each, and that
said men would be recorded as having
enlisted from the town of Sudbury, and
credit would be given to the town for said
men by the proper authorities, and the
