To Samuel A Jones Constable of the
Town of Sudbury in said County. Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury, qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the Town Hall in said Sudbury on Monday the second day of March next at ten o'clock in the forenoon, then and there to act on the following Articles, viz

- Art 1 To choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting,
- Art 2 To choose all necessary town officers for the year ensuing
- Art 3 To determine the manner of collecting repairing Highways, Townways and Bridges the ensuing year and grant money to carry the same into effect, to do or act in any way on said subject of repairing Highways as the Town may think proper
- Art 4 To see if the Town will establish branch Libraries in the different districts of the town or where most needed, to do or act as the town may think best,
- Art 5 To see if the town will authorize their Assessors to apportion to the Warden of the Poor Farm all the road adjoining said farm, to keep in repair the ensuing year to do or act as the town may judge best,
- Art 6 To hear the report of the Committee chosen to build a Library Building and act thereon
