

Art 7 To hear the report of the Committee chosen to purchase books for a library from the bequest of the late John Goodnow of Boston, and pass any votes relative thereto as the town may think best

Art 8 To see if the Town will choose a Librarian to take care of the Goodnow Library and fix the compensation for said service, to do or act in any way on said subject as the town may think best

Art 9 To hear and act on reports and pass any votes relative to the same as the town may think proper

Art 10 To see if the town will discount any Taxes that may be offered for that purpose.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting an attested copy thereof at the Town house, at each of the Public Meeting houses and at some public place in the village of Asabel in said Town, two Sabbaths at least before the time appointed for holding said meeting.

Verely fail not and make due return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk on or before the time of meeting as aforesaid
