

Art 3 Voted to grant the sum of one thousand dollars for repairs of Highways Town ways and Bridges the ensuing year, to be distributed and expended in the same manner as last year.

Voted also to instruct the proper officer or officers to collect a fine of ten dollars, of each and every Surveyor of Highways who makes no return to said officers at the end of his term of office as required by law.

Art 4 Voted to pass over this Article

Art 5 Voted to instruct the Assessors to apportion to the Warden of the Poor farm, all the road adjoining said farm, to keep in repair the ensuing year.

Art 6 The committee chosen to build a library building stated to the town that they had not finished the work assigned them, and were not ready to report.

Art 7 The committee chosen to purchase books for the Goodnow Library, not having completed the duty assigned to them, were not prepared to report in full, but said committee, reported a list of Rules and Regulations, drafted by them for the management of said Library, which, after being amended, were accepted and adopted by the town.

Voted, also, that the committee above referred to, shall be the committee chosen by the town in accordance with said rules and regulations and shall hold said office until the first Monday in April A.D. 1864

Voted that the Selectmen of the last year, be instructed to pay over to the Selectmen of the present year, the balance of the bequest of the late John Goodnow of Boston, now remaining in their hands.
