Any person retaining a book beyond the time specified on the label thereon, shall pay a fine of two and a half per. cent. on the cost of the book, for every Library day during which it shall be so retained; provided, however, that the aggregate of the fines shall in no case exceed the cost of the Book.

IX.

If any damage shall be done to a book while out of the charge of the Librarian, the amount of damage shall be assessed by him to the person to whom, or to whose order, the book was delivered. And if any person who has been fined, or assessed as herein before provided, shall refuse or neglect to pay said fine or assessment, he, and the household to which he belongs, shall be deprived of the benefit of the Library until payment be made.

X

No person shall be allowed to take books from the shelves, except those who have charge of the Library.
