In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs, and on the Articles of Amendment of the Constitution of this Commonwealth, to meet at the Town Hall, in said Sudbury, on Monday, the 6th day of April next, at nine o'clock, A.M. (Polls open for the Article of Amendment of the Constitution at Eleven o'clock A.M.) then and there to act on the following Articles, Viz

- 1 To bring in their votes to the Selectmen on the twenty-third Article of the Articles of Amendment to the Constitution of this Commonwealth, "Yes" or "No":
- 2 To Choose a Moderator, to preside in said meeting
- 3 To fill all vacancies of Town Officers, if there are any
- 4 To grant all necessary money to pay Town expenses for the year ensuing; do or act in reference to said money as the town think best.
- 5 To hear and act on reports and pass any votes relative to the same as the town may think best.
- 6 To hear the report of the Library building Committee and act thereon.
- 7 To hear the report of the Committee chosen to purchase books for a Library from the bequest of the late John Goodnow of Boston and pass any votes relative thereto as the town may think best.
