

- 16 To see if the Town will give the Library building Committee any instructions in regard to building a fence between the Library Ground and land of Martin Goodnow; or take any action on the subject of said Library ground that the town shall think best.
- 17 To see if the town will either partially equalize our access to the town books by fitting by fitting up libraries in the Town House and at Assabet Village, or devise any other and better way for meeting our general wants.
- 18 To determine the manner of collecting Taxes the present year, and agree with some suitable person to collect the same;
- 19 To see if the town will choose a committee or committees to make the distributions of the "Elisha Goodnow" and other funds:
- 20 To see if the town will pay any bounty to those soldiers who first enlisted into the service of the United States in addition to the sum of ten dollars paid at the time of enlistment, to do or act as the town may think best.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copies thereof at the Town House, at each of the public meeting-houses and at some public place in the village of Assabet in said town, two Sabbaths at least before the time appointed for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the town Clerk at or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
