the Articles in the preceding warrant were
taken up and acted upon as follows, Viz:

Art 2 Chose Capt James Moore, Moderator.

3^d Chose Abel Parmenter, and Jesse Parmenter
Surveyors of Highways, in place Addison
Parmenter and Miram Garrison, chosen at
March meeting, but not qualified.

Voted to dispense with the choice of
field Drivers to fill vacancies.

4 Voted to grant money for the following Purposes, Viz:
For support of Schools and fuel for the same \$1450.00
To pay expenses on account of River Meadow Smt. \$115 00
" " Incidental Expenses - 600 00
" " Interest on Jerusha Howe fund 60 00
" " Deficiency of Incidental expense and
expense of Building Ground Wall, 318 00
To refund, in part, money borrowed to pay
Soldier's Bounty and interest on the same 1343 80
To pay Ellen Hudson as per vote of the Town 100 00
To pay interest on money borrowed to pay State aid 250 00
For Support of Poor 700 00
