- Apr 11 Then the Moderator let out the taking care of the Town House to William H Bent for the sum of sixteen dollars, said Bent being the lowest bidder therefor.
- Apr 12 Voted to instruct the Treasurer of the Library Committee to effect an insurance against fire upon the Goodnow Library and building
- 13 Voted to pass over this Article
- 14 Voted to transfer the fund known as the "Goodnow Library Fund", and all the liabilities and responsibilities connected therewith, from the Town Treasurer, to the Treasurer of the Library Committee, and that said Treasury be required to give bonds to the satisfaction of said Library Committee, for the faithful discharge of all duties connected with said Fund and the care thereof.
- 15 Voted to pass over this Article
- 16 Voted to leave the subject referred to in this article with the library Committee, with the authority of the Town to take such action as said Committee may think proper
- 17 Voted to Passover this Article
- 18 Voted that all taxes against non residents not exceeding in amount the sum of five dollars be made payable on demand, and in all other particulars the taxes shall be made payable and collected in the same manner as last year. Then let out the collecting of said Taxes to Samuel A. Jones for the sum of forty dollars (he being the lowest bidder therefor) said sum to be payment in full for all services as Collector of Taxes.
