At a meeting of the Town Clerks of the Towns of
 Sudbury, Stow and Wayland, (said towns com-
 posing the Sixteenth Middlesex Representative
 District) held at the Town Hall in Sudbury on
 Wednesday Nov 4th 1863, it appeared by the records
 of meetings in said towns that the whole number
 of votes for a Representative to the General Court of
 Massachusetts for said District was, four hundred
 and eighty eight - that Rev Erastus Dickinson
 of Sudbury had two hundred ninety eight, and Rich-
 ard R. Morr of Sudbury had one hundred and ninety.
