At a Legal Town Meeting holden at Sudbury on Monday December 7th AD 1863. the articles in the above warrant were acted upon as follows

Art 2 Voted to Authorize the Selectmen use all proper and legal measures to fill up the town's quota of volunteers agreeable to the call referred to in this Article - to call public meetings and employ speakers from abroad, if they think proper, at the expense of the Town.

Art 3 Voted to pass over this Article
