To Samuel A. Jones, a Constable of the Town
of Sudbury in said County. Greeting;

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massa-
chusetts, you are directed to notify and warn
the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, qual-
ified to vote in town affairs, to meet at the
Town Hall in said Sudbury, on Monday, the
seventh day of March next, at ten o'clock in
the forenoon, there and there to act on
the following Articles, viz:

- Art 1st To choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting.
- Art 2^d To choose all necessary town officers for the
year ensuing
- Art 3^d To choose a Librarian for the "Goodnow Li-
brary and fix the compensation for the ser-
vices of said Librarian.
- Art. 4. To determine the manner of repairing Highways,
Townways and Bridges, the year ensuing, and
grant money to carry the same into effect; to
do or act in any way on said subject as the
town may think proper.
- Art 5. To see if the Town will take any measures to repair
Pantry Bridge, so called; also the bridge near
Rogers Mill; to do or act in any way in reference
to said bridges as the Town may judge best.
- Art 6 To see if the Town will purchase gravel pits
in the highway wards where they may be needed
to repair the roads in said wards; to do or act to
