- Art 5 think proper, and for the interest of the Town; then chose Andrew Hunt, Abel B. Jones and Leander Heynes for said Committee.
- Art 6 Voted to authorize the Selectmen to purchase gravel pits in any of the highway wards in town where, in their opinion such purchase may be necessary for the repair of the roads
- Art 7 The Town voted to adopt certain amendments to the first, third, sixth, seventh and eighth articles of the "By-Laws for the Regulation of the Goodnow Library"; so that, the form of said Articles, as recorded on page 238, 239 and 240 of this book of Records, shall be changed to read as follows: viz:

- I. - The management of the Goodnow Library shall be entrusted to a Committee of six persons, to be chosen by the town, - one from each of the six School Districts; and at the annual Town Meeting, on the first Monday of April A. D. 1864, two of said Committee shall be chosen for the term of one year - two for two years and two for three years; after which, two of said Committee shall be chosen annually on the first Monday of April, for the term of three years. Said Committee, as soon as practicable after their election, shall proceed to organize, by the choice of a Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer.
- III. - It shall be the duty of the Librarian to attend to the delivery and return of books belonging to the Library, and to keep an accurate record of the same; to keep the room and books in good order; to cover and label all new books furnished for the Library, as directed by the Library Committee; to cover and label anew all books belonging to the Library, when the covers or labels thereof shall become worn or defaced; to collect all fines which may be incurred; to assess and collect all damage for harm done to books, and pay the same to the
